## Message from our President:

## December 2009

Can you believe that it is already December? The year has flown by so fast. December is usually a “rest” month for Emmaus. And for good reason – so you can serve with fervor in your local church. There is no board meeting in December, and the only ones doing much of anything are the spring Lay Directors. But let me tell you – we were not goofing off in November! Your board of directors made some key decisions that will be affecting The Louisville Area Walk to Emmaus for years to come. Let me tell you about them.

On October 31, we held the clergy training and certification seminar. Rev. Garry Speich came from Nashville to present the seminar, and it was well received by everyone that I talked to. If you will remember, I told you in January 2009 that the new clergy requirements should have been in effect in 2007. That is why we had some urgency around getting them implemented. Your board voted unanimously to follow these new guidelines for every Walk to Emmaus held in 2010 and beyond. It also came up during this program that we are outside the Upper Room model by broadcasting the talks in the prayer room. They are adamant that what is said in the conference room is ONLY for the conference room, and it is up to us as a board to protect the speaker’s confidentiality. Because of this, we voted unanimously to stop broadcasting the talks outside the conference room. We also voted to rent a post office box for our community mail, because too many applications are being lost before they get to us. Please see Jane’s article later in this newsletter.

For the outgoing Community Lay Director, December is a time to look back to see what has been accomplished during that year. As I look back at the February newsletter, where I outlined for you the things we wanted to get accomplished this year, I would say that your 16-person board did a VERY good job this year. Most of them have worked very hard in trying to serve you with excellence in all that they did. When you see one of them, please give them a big thank you! We will also miss the people who will be finishing their elected terms – Don Craig, Mike Welker, Charles Stallard, George Jones, Perry Probst, and Steve Homola.

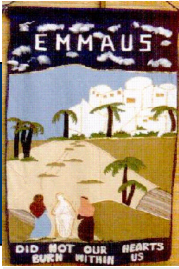

### *Serving Meals...*

It is recommended that you not serve more than once during the weekend, especially if you are a sponsor. When coming to serve park in the lot to the right as you enter the front of the conference center. Enter the building from the back deck--there will be signs directing you--and proceed to the kitchen. The Kitchen Team will give you directions on what needs to be done. Remember that you'll need to be there for approximately one hour after the meal to assist in clean-up and setting up for the next meal. Don't forget to leave your watches, phones, pagers, etc. in the car!

### **Snack Agape Reminder:**

Please remember to...**bring your snack agape to the Sendoff...** if at all possible. It helps the Team to better judge the amount of agape for the weekend and reduces the last minute pleas (for snack agape) we've had on previous weekends.
