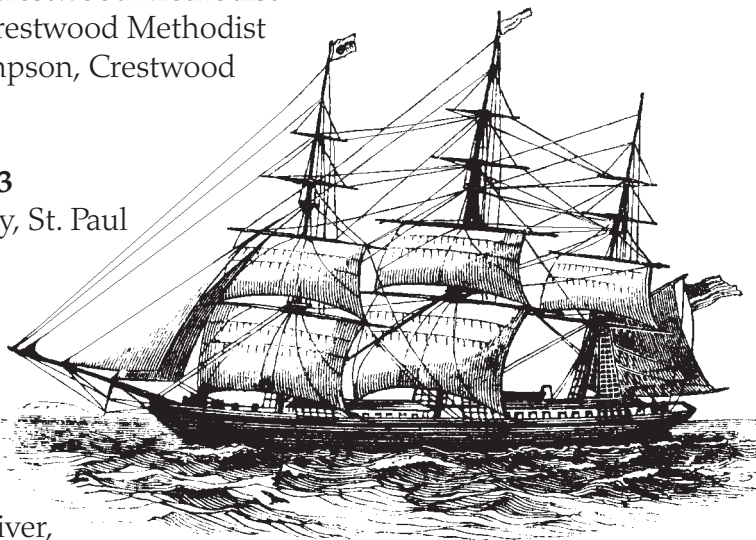

REC wants you

Greetings from the REC Board! We bring you good news from the local prisons, where the REC movement is growing like wild fire.

At the most recent REC at the women's prison, 140 women signed up to attend (we can only take 60) and another 60 participated as sponsors. Out of a population of 720, 28 percent wanted to take part in the REC.

REC is Residents Encounter Christ, an Emmaus-like weekend designed for the prison setting. REC takes place twice a year at the Kentucky Correctional Institution for Women and Luther Lockett Correctional Complex, and once a year at the Kentucky State Reformatory. This year we are reaching out to youthful offenders with an RECYouth Weekend at the Jefferson County Youth Center.

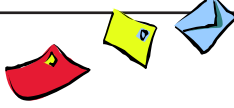

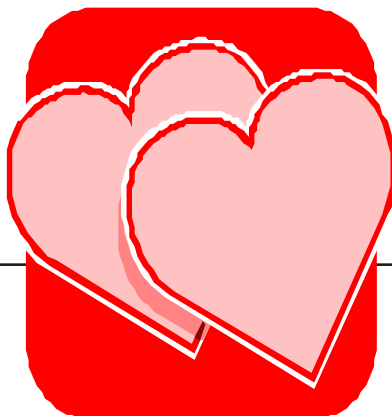
