## Message from our President:

**November 2009**

On October 31 we had our long awaited clergy training and certification seminar given by the Upper Room. This seminar was meant to help those clergy who do not qualify under the new guidelines, the opportunity to get that certification. Garry Speich, the southeast regional clergy representative from Nashville came to Christ Church UMC to host this event. 20 of our local clergy gave up their Saturday morning to attend the event, and it was well received by everyone that I had the opportunity to talk to. Most of the questions that we had about the new requirements have been answered and we are on the road to full compliance. This brings us to our next point – compliance with the Upper Room model. As most of you already know, The Walk to Emmaus program is managed by the Upper Room, which is a part of the United Methodist Church. What some of you may not realize is that there is a copyright on every piece of the program. We cannot pick and choose which pieces we want to follow and which pieces we want to ignore. Every member of your board signs a yearly covenant with the Upper Room that says we will do our best to follow the model. To the Upper Room's credit, they do allow the individual communities to make some very small changes that are called "local flavors". But there are some things that are not negotiable, and the criterion for clergy certification is one of them. Beginning with the March 2010 walks we will be following these guidelines completely. We will be encouraging the Cornerstone Chrysalis Community to do the same thing. Hopefully, this will help insure that the Walk to Emmaus that we know and love will continue to be one of the instruments that our God uses to change lives and grow new leaders for His church.

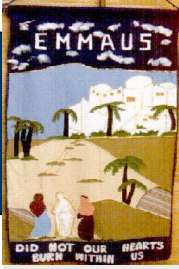

### *Serving Meals...*

It is recommended that you not serve more than once during the weekend, especially if you are a sponsor.
