


# Talk From the Walk

### Serving Meals...

It is recommended that you not serve more than once during the weekend, especially if you are a sponsor. When coming to serve park in the lot to the right as you enter the front of the conference center. We are now coming up on the R.E.C.'s busiest time. We have 3 weekends in the next 6 weeks. During this time, we will reach almost 200 residents and over a hundred different staff members in the three different prison facilities. There are 3 teams meeting and praying for these residents and officers right now, praying that they will be open to the Holy Spirit as we walk in the doors of those prisons.

While we are there, each step we take, everything we do will be analyzed and judged and questioned, by resident and staff member alike. Are they real? Do they really mean what they say? Do they really live the lives they talk about? Do they really love us unconditionally? Then the deeper questions come, does God really love me? Can He truly forgive me? I can't forgive myself and my family doesn't forgive, why does God? Can I really succeed in life outside these walls? Some of the questions come from the team members, when watching the news I have to ask myself sometimes, why do we do this prison ministry? Some of the people we see in the news have done some really horrible things! Then God reminds me that no matter what we've done in our lives, or what they have done in their lives, we deserve and they deserve to know Jesus. It's our job to show them Jesus, sometimes that's just a smile, or a handshake or just sitting down and listening, really listening to someone tell their story.

Please be in prayer for KSR and their 60 residents and staff, for RCC and their 72 residents and staff, and for KCIW, their 60 residents and staff, and always for the teams that are willing to step out in faith and be analyzed, judged and questioned about their Jesus.

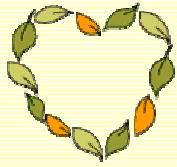

## Pre-Gathering Chili Supper



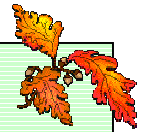
